**REVISED PASSENGER SERVICE CHARGES**

1. With effect from December 01, 2008 the following charges are applicable for **J. A. Pengel International Airport (SMJP)**.

**1.1 LANDING CHARGES**

Basis: Maximum permissible take-off mass in the Certificate of Airworthiness.

A. International traffic:

Aircraft weight

Charge

Up to 5 000 KG  
5001 KG and over

US\$ 25.00 fixed charge  
US\$ 5.50 per 1 000 KG or part thereof

B. Domestic traffic:

US\$ 25.00

C. Training flights:

US\$ 5.00 per 1 000 KG

**1.2 PARKING CHARGES:**

BASIS: Maximum take-off mass.

First 4 hours free, thereafter:

US\$ 0.50 per 1 000 KG or part thereof per 24 hours or part thereof.

### **1.3 PASSENGER SERVICE CHARGES**

Per departing international passenger, two years old and above:

a. Passenger facility charge	US\$ 35.00
b. Terminal-fee	US\$ 25.00
c. Safety-fee	US\$ 6.00

Exempts are:

- a. children less than 2 years of age;
- b. holders of diplomatic passes/passports;
- c. crew members on duty of aircraft;
- d. transit passengers, in transit within 48 hours after arrival.

### **1.4 FUEL CHARGE**

Payable by fuel supplier.  
US\$ 0.02 per gallon

## **2. AIR NAVIGATION FACILITY CHARGES**

**2.1** For the use of air navigation facilities and services including communication:

A International flight:
