### **AERONAUTICAL INFORMATION CIRCULAR**

Airmen are hereby informed that, as of the 24<sup>th</sup> of JAN 2022, until further notice, all flight operations to and from the interior of Suriname, are permitted.

The manifests should be submitted with the flight plan to TOWER SMZO ([towersmzo@gmail.com](mailto:towersmzo@gmail.com)) and cc to ([dca@cadsur.sr](mailto:dca@cadsur.sr)) & ([e.alphons@cadsur.sr](mailto:e.alphons@cadsur.sr)).

The manifest of the flights from the interior should be submitted after the flight, upon arrival.

Medical flights shall file a request of approval with 24 hours prior notice to the Head of Civil Aviation Department ([dca@cadsur.sr](mailto:dca@cadsur.sr)) and the secretariat of the Minister of TCT ([secmin.tct@gov.sr](mailto:secmin.tct@gov.sr)).

Emergency flights shall submit a manifest to the Head of Civil Aviation Department ([dca@cadsur.sr](mailto:dca@cadsur.sr)) and the secretariat of the Minister of TCT ([secmin.tct@gov.sr](mailto:secmin.tct@gov.sr)). It can also be submitted after the flight, upon arrival.

The passenger manifest for oil, gas and mining flights must be sent to the Head of Civil Aviation Department ([dca@cadsur.sr](mailto:dca@cadsur.sr)) and ([secmin.tct@gov.sr](mailto:secmin.tct@gov.sr)), at least 48 hours in advance.
